

In RECLIP we are collectively focused and committed to improve the lives of children, promoting high quality clinical research in Spain, for which clinical trials are essential.

We provide the know-how and the infrastructure that allows high-quality pediatric clinical research to take place in the Spanish healthcare system, providing that children can benefit from new and better diagnostic, preventive and therapeutic option.

RECLIP gives a professional answer to the specific needs of clinical trials and particularly those inherent to pediatric studies, ensuring that children needs are at the very center of all our activities.

## centres & classification criteria



- **Consolidated centre:** Fully dedicated staff and structure for paediatric clinical trials. At least 5 started clinical trials in 3 or more thematic areas in the last 4 years.
- **Thematic centre:** Fully dedicated staff and structure for paediatric clinical trials. At least 5 started clinical trials in 1 or 2 thematic areas in the last 4 years.
- **Emerging centre:** Not fulfilling previous criteria but at least 2 started clinical trials per year.

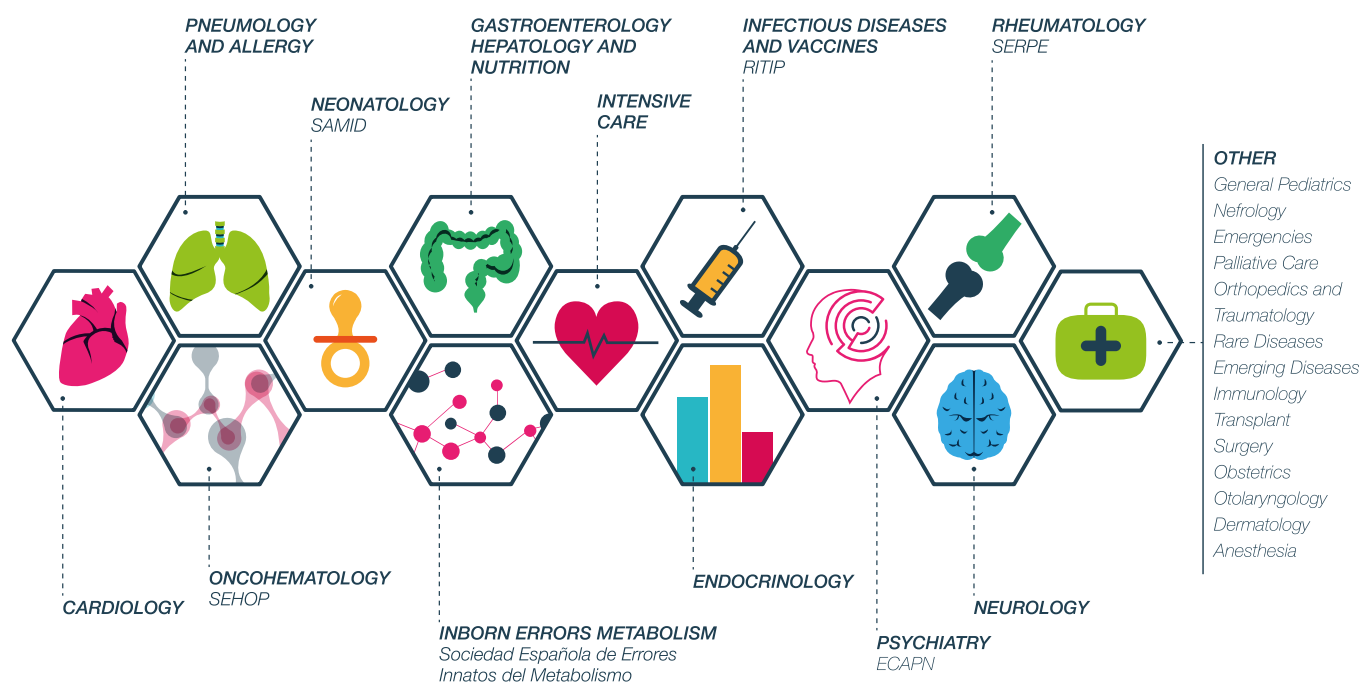


## mission & vision

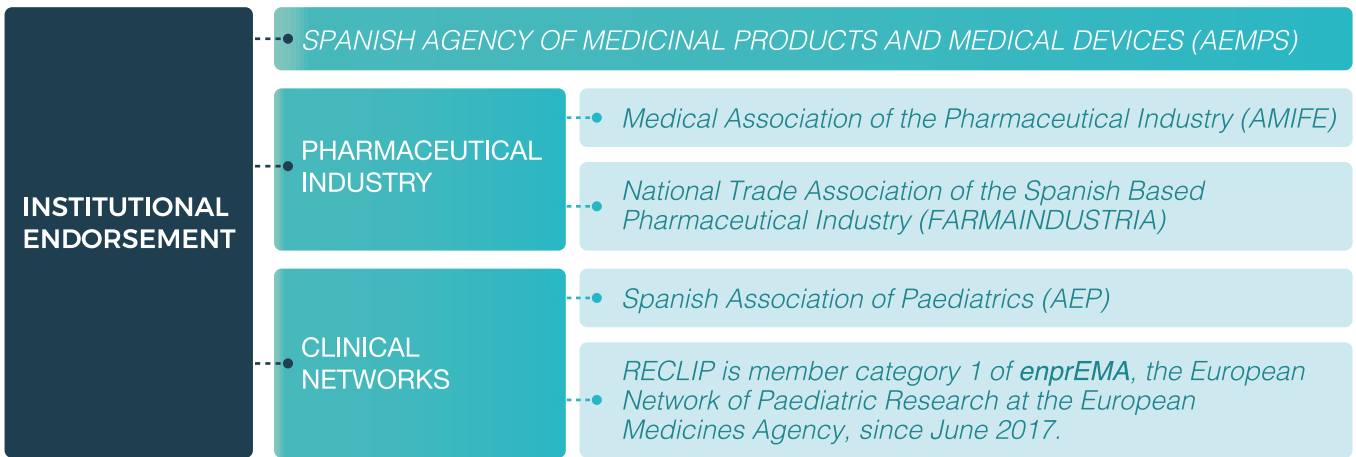

- 04** To speed up the approval of innovative medicines and medical devices by harmonizing and standardizing the common procedures involved in clinical trials.

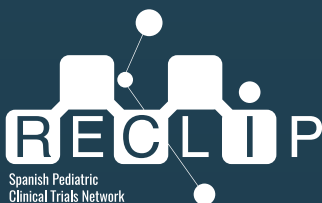
